And fairway woods, with their longer shafts, are not designed to deliver long-iron distance. Choking down on a fairway wood only invites disaster. But now there's a better way.

### SHORTER IS LONGER

Conventional wisdom has it that a longer shaft will give you more distance. But the longer the shaft, the more small mistakes are magnified. A small movement in your grip or swing means a major movement at the end of a long shaft.

When you line up a shot with the Middleclub, you will immediately notice that the shaft is shorter than your present iron.

By altering the proximity between your eyes and hands, and the ball, you will get more accuracy and control than you ever thought possible with a long-iron.



Our exclusive Cobalt 57 clubhead is heavier than a typical fairway wood. The result is a solid feel, more control and as much or more distance than the corresponding numbered iron.

The Middleclub also has one of the lowest centers of gravity in the game, so you can be assured of getting the ball up cleanly every time.

The clubface produces a trampoline-like effect which, by the way, conforms with USGA Rules.

After rigorous testing, players of all handicaps report that the patent pending Middleclub is much easier to hit and control, and their shots go as far or farther than long-irons.
